



TYSON'S TALE

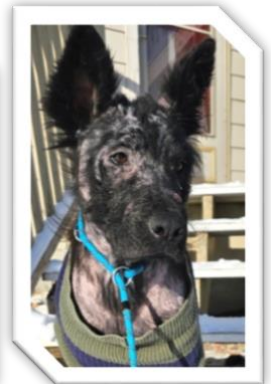
You may have seen the heartwarming posts of Tyson, found cold and alone in a culvert in dangerously cold temperatures. Tyson's story highlights challenges faced by stray dogs, already battling homelessness, and the heightened danger of mange in winter.

Mange, caused by mites, is marked by itching, hair loss, and red skin. In winter, this condition becomes even more critical as the thick coat meant for insulation against the cold is compromised.

While mange is a common challenge in rescue, its impact is especially severe during winter. It's not just uncomfortable, it's life-threatening. The loss of fur, meant to regulate temperature and provide warmth, exposes animals to the harsh elements.

Tyson was fortunate. He was rescued, treated, loved, and is now happily adopted. However, the urgency remains for stray dogs battling mange, especially in the unforgiving winter months. Your support has been instrumental in witnessing incredible recoveries for those who cannot speak for themselves. Tyson's tale is a testament to the impact of animal rescue!

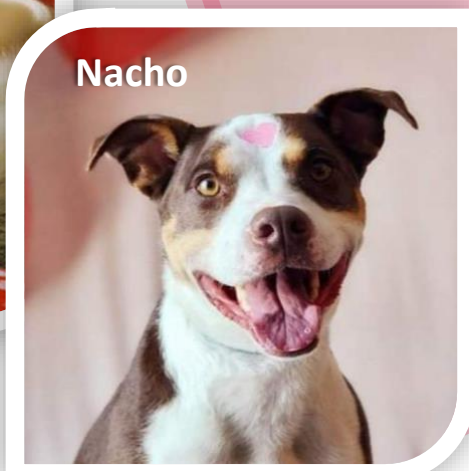

OUR JANUARY JOURNEY

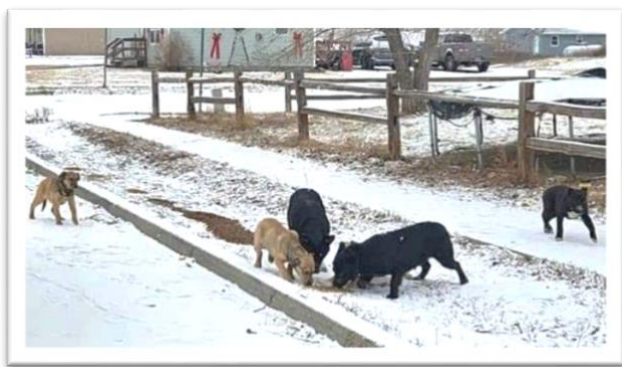

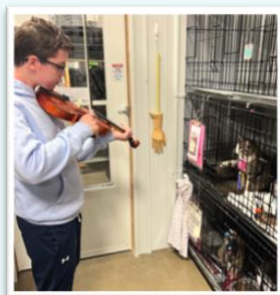
Gratitude for those in our communities who stepped up, offering shelter and support. Gratitude for our volunteers and fosters who stood strong, digging deep and rising to each challenge.

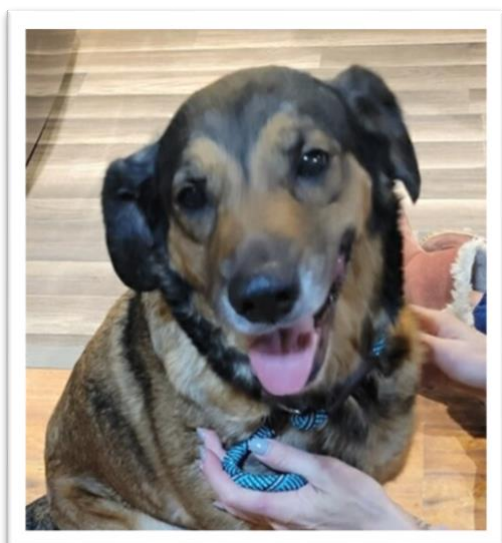

THE MICROCHIP MYSTERY

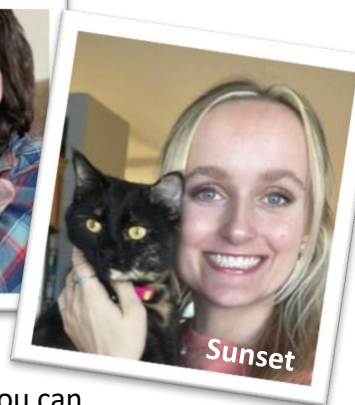
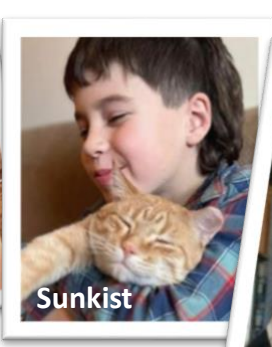
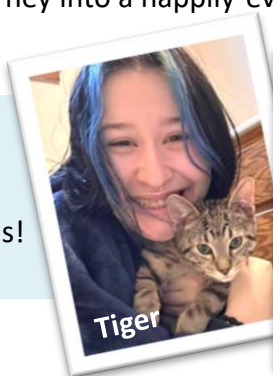
Not so long ago, I found myself wandering the streets, the wind carrying whispers of family, love, and a forever home. A kind group of humans from FFRR took me in and cared for me.

We're at PetSmart every Saturday from 11-2 with adoptable cats. Come see us!

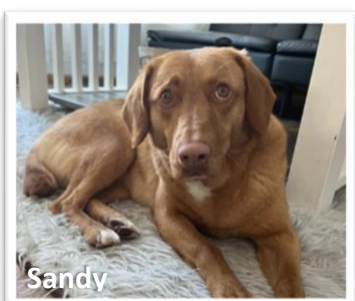


DID YOU KNOW?

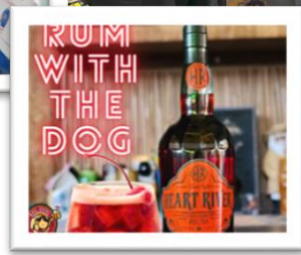
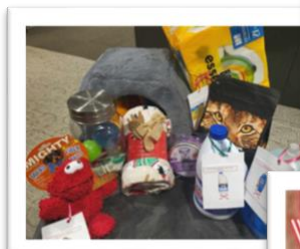
